Following the Arlington sponsored luncheon, Team Fastrax, a professional skydiving team, performed their stunning patriotic flag jump. Goodin, a current candidate for Hamilton County Clerk of Courts is a veteran of the XVII Airborne Corps and former Cincinnati City Councilman and Assistant Hamilton County Prosecutor.
