

HILLGROVE UNION CEMETERY IS OFFERING GRAVE SITE WREATHS FOR WINTER



Hillgrove Union Cemetery and local Boy Scout Troop #103 are teaming up to offer a new wreath program as a way of decorating grave sites for the upcoming holiday and winter season. Community members are invited to purchase wreaths to beautify the grave site of their loved ones.

Live 24-inch Frasier Fir wreaths are available for purchase through Nov. 25 for \$30 each. The wreaths are adorned with frosted pine cones and a red velvet bow. They will be placed on grave sites—supported by a small stand—by Dec. 7 and remain in place through February 2014.

The Hillgrove Union Cemetery is located at 1002 E. Central Ave. in Miamisburg and is operated jointly by the City of Miamisburg and Miami Township. The historic 30-acre facility was established in 1863.
