Spring Cleaning

Now that we are nearing springtime blooms, it's time to clean up and help enhance the natural beauty of the cemetery. As of March 1st, all winter decorations were removed. We are back to our weekly clean offs as outlined in our 2020 Calendar for Adornment Removal. Please keep in mind that Woodland Cemetery reserves the right to clean off prohibited, unsightly and/or dangerous adornments at any time.

Tips to Keep in Mind

Our mowing crews are always at work as long as the weather permits. They will move through areas of the cemetery at a rate of once a week for the mowers and up to once every three weeks for the trimmers. Trimmers will go around every memorial on the ground which mandates the need for a regimented decor policy. Here are some things to keep in mind when planning your decor and visits.



No space is permitted to have brick, tile, stone marbles, sand or any other type of edging material.



Please remember as things are moved around by weather, we do not know where they should be returned to, and in these cases, items are disposed of as they are picked up by our grounds crew.



Graves that allow for a flush or bevel marker are permitted to have loose flowers put on the grave or marker. These graves will be cleared on a regular basis so that crews and their equipment can care for the grounds properly.

Upright Monuments

If you own an upright monument, we do allow plantings in front of monumental lots. Flowers may be planted on monument lots but only within 18 inches in-front of the foundation of the monument. Please keep in mind that it is the family's responsibility to tend to the plantings. Annual and perennial flower are permitted; no shrubs, bushes or trees. Woodland reserves the right to remove any plantings which are overgrown or encroaching on other burial spaces. More information on plantings can be found on our website or in the main office.



Headstone Cleaning and Restoration Workshops






We get many inquiries in regards to headstone cleaning. Woodland is pleased to partner with gravestone restoration expert Misti Spillman of Reviving Cemeteries, Inc. Misti will conduct a series of workshops for those who are interested in headstone cleaning and restoration. Cost is \$30 for the Beginners class and \$50 for the Advanced class. Workshops will be conducted at Woodland Cemetery and Arboretum from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays May 16, June 20, August 15 and September 19, 2020.

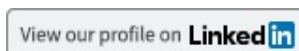
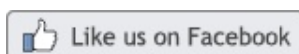
