





# History Of Oak Grove Cemetery

During a public meeting on June 29, 1850, an appointed committee decided that the present burial grounds, situated on the east side of Henry Street, was in deplorable condition and unable to meet the future needs of our growing community.

On September 6, 1850, fifty acres with a small frame house, about one mile south of the center of town was purchased from Alexander Kilbourne for \$1550. After clearing some of the land, building roads and laying out the lots, dedication ceremonies were held on July 20, 1851. The first burial was of Elizabeth McCracken on July 23, 1851.

On April 14, 1863, a conference was held by the Council of the incorporated Village of Delaware and the Trustees of Oak Grove Cemetery.



Council resolved to purchase Oak Grove Cemetery assuming all debts of the association.

In 1889, the old burial ground was deemed closed for any further burials. Then, in August 1891, an additional forty-two acres were purchased and became a part of Oak Grove Cemetery.

In March 1901, approximately 647 of the remains and monuments from the old burial grounds were moved to Oak Grove, some buried on family plots, while the majority were placed in a section now called "The Old Graveyard." One hundred remains had already been removed prior to 1889.

In 1905 a group of business leaders met to form and write the Articles of Incorporation for the Oak Grove Cemetery Company. One year later on February 19, 1906, Council voted to turn the cemetery over to the Oak Grove Cemetery Company, Board of Trustees.





In February 1999, 147 bodies were moved to Oak Grove from the Delaware Mausoleum which sat on the hill across from the Sandusky St. gate. Two granite monuments were erected in the

"Mausoleum" section inscribed with the names of those interred in the section.

For over 100 years the cemetery was owned and operated by the Board of Directors. Then, on September 27, 2012, a meeting was held by The Oak Grove Cemetery Association, Board of Directors. Once again,



due to financial strains, they were forced to dissolve the cemetery association. On November 1, 2012, with the approval of City Council, ownership of the cemetery was transferred and the reins of the cemetery were turned over to the City of Delaware.

A tour of Oak Grove by foot or by car is a trip back into the history of Delaware. Monuments can be found of pioneers, senators, authors, generals, governors, merchants, teachers, community leaders, veterans of all wars, and the list goes on. Each and every person with their own story to tell.

Even though the city has grown around the cemetery, Oak Grove has remained a beautiful peaceful sanctuary. The natural beauty of the rolling hills, abundant trees, flowers and wildlife has been preserved.

As you visit these hallowed grounds look around at the history, remember and cherish our past and look forward to our future.



# CREMATORY OPERATOR CERTIFICATION SEMINAR & ADVANCED CREMATORY OPERATIONS PROGRAM

The Ohio Cemetery Association in conjunction with Matthews International will be hosting a Crematory Operator Certification Seminar on August 7, 2014 and an Advanced Crematory Operations Program on August 8<sup>th</sup>. The seminars will be held at Cincinnati Marriott North, 6189 Mulhauser Rd., West Chester Ohio.

Topics include Ethics & Professionalism in the Crematory; Advanced Operating Techniques; Cremation Liabilities and a professionally prepared series of operation videos that demonstrate each step of the cremation process from receiving to refrigeration, loading to retrieval, and processing and packaging. Also included are videos entitled "You Make the Call" that challenge the critical thinking of the attendees.




