


President's Message

2018 OCA FALL MAINTENANCE SEMINAR AT SPRING GROVE CEMETERY AND ABORETUM

We are looking forward to hosting the 2018 OCA Fall Maintenance Seminar which will take place on Tuesday, October 2nd in our Rose Garden/Norman Chapel area. The theme this year is "A GREEN FUTURE". Registration will be 8:00 – 9:00 a.m.

We will be talking about how environmentally friendly is your cemetery? Do you allow artificial flowers and decoration during the growing season (April – October)? We also will have speakers from *Mean Green Equipment* and demos of battery fueled mowers, trimers, and blowers. Steve Folz from the Cincinnati Zoo will be here to speak about low maintenance, drought resistant plant material to use in your cemetery.

There will also be talks on Safety and holding events in your cemetery. The ever-popular mower obstacle course is being planned as well as the backhoe competition to see who is the best operator in 2018! Tours will be ongoing all day which will take small groups out into the grounds to visit our crematory/Funeral home, Lakeside III construction site, Sections 130 & 142F cremation walkway and our Green Burial section. The tour will also stop by the OCA time capsule/ICCFA memorial.

We hope to see you all here on October 2nd.

Here are some interesting facts about Spring Grove Cemeteries, Funeral Homes, Crematory & Arboretum:

Spring Grove was chartered in 1845 and today has grown to encompass 750 acres, of which 450 acres are currently developed. We have around 1300 burials a year. We have our own crematory and will do about 650 cremations this year. We are building our 9th public Mausoleum this year (Lakeside III). We built our first funeral home in 1999 on our property and now have four funeral homes around the city. They were renamed this past year to reflect our cemetery's name of *Spring Grove*. We also have a second cemetery in the tricounty area called *Oak Hill Cemetery*. Oak hill is 160 acres - 62 acres are developed, and they have around 300 burials a year. Our company employs about 240 people.

Crowne Vault exhibited at the Ohio Cemetery Association convention this year and sales rep Michelle Lacay brought something new. "We introduced an addition to our 'royal family' and wanted to share the news with Ohioans!" The compact-size Coronet Urn Vault joins the Regent and the Marquis to provide a choice of capacity and styling that is just right for different interment scenarios.

The Coronet was designed to hold just the temporary container and has a height of only 7.5". It works well for second rites of interment where the ground depth could be an issue. The Coronet can allow for a smaller footprint for a cremation garden and may make areas near fence lines more usable for cremation burial. Its small size requires less work to inter and it comes with the same water-proof sealant as the Regent and Marquis. Dignified burials are always the goal.

Crowne Vaults are known for their sturdiness, spacious capacity, easy-seal feature and choice of colors. Most valued by families is how Crowne Vaults can be personalized by friends and family. Permanent markers allow families to leave a lasting impression of their love. The attractive design provides a comforting 'last look'. Best of all, Crowne Vaults are affordable.

For more than a decade, cemeteries have used the Regent single size to accommodate a standard-size urn or two temporary containers plus memorabilia. Additionally, the Regent can be used as a pre-born infant casket. The larger capacity Marquis double was designed to hold two tall urns or one over-sized urn and can also fit 6 temporary inserts.

Crowne Vault, a division of Cressy Memorial Group is based in Mishawaka, Indiana and manufactures a line of urn vaults which are Made in the USA. Cressy Memorial is a manufacturers' representative agency which works with memorial distributors to promote Howard Miller Memorials, R&S (marble) Designs and Crowne Vaults.

So, thank you for letting us be part of your event! Crowne Vault sales rep Michelle Lacay felt welcomed and had fun being on the winning team for Family Feud. While at the conference she enjoyed interesting conversations, gathered new knowledge and formed pleasant associations.





We are seeing lots of Japanese Beetles and Masked Chafer adults here in Central and Southern Ohio this you nuch earlier than in "normal " years! We have also enjoyed a fairly wet summer, which is critical for grul arvae development. Combined together, we have a "Perfect Storm" brewing for huge grub populations are lamage here in September and October! If you have not applied season long grub control products such as or Allectus, keep a careful eye on your turf for the next 2-3 months! If you find grub populations of more the grubs per square foot within your lawn, you will need to use a curative insecticide such as Meridian, Aloft only Dylox.
